I was really anxious to get back to my room because I planned to help Lisa devour the delicious treats. On my way back, however, I lost my balance and fell right into the hole... nothing could have prepared me for what I was about to see.

I landed sideways on my right knee and hip, facing the boiler room area. My eyes slammed shut as I lay there for a few seconds. Although I was hurt, I felt no pain once I opened my eyes because I saw several demonic spirits and the shock overrode every other feeling in my body. They were everywhere, but mostly by the boiler. One specific spirit seemed as if it led the pack. It was a grey, witch-like old lady's spirit that looked like a dead body. It was the answer to the problem and even at that age I was able to sleep, knowing that God would protect me.

By the time I turned nine my mom had saved enough money to purchase a house in Freeport, Long Island. My father had been squandering away the profits made at the store with careless women and my mom quickly grew tired of the situation. It was a tense time for everyone in my family; my parents argued on a daily basis. I'll never forget when my dad left my mom. I was about eleven years old. I was quickly forced to assume the responsibilities of running the family business after school. I was the man of the house. My mom's shift changed. She worked from 3pm to 11pm. When the school bell rang at 2:15pm I knew to make sure I was at the store by 2:40pm, so that I could relieve my mom and she could get ready for work. My mother was a very hard-working woman who diligently carried out her responsibilities (and she still is). This became my daily routine. I started to make my way towards the curb and about a minute later my car stalled, then rolled to a complete stop. What a disappointing disaster! I was officially broken down, in my favorite, new car and I guess we were all shocked because no one made a sound. I immediately popped open the hood and got out to see if I could find the problem. Because it had just started to rain, it was nasty, cold and wet. I could hear the loud sizzle-like splashes from the non-stop traffic, but one particular noise grabbed my attention. Still standing in front of my car, I leaned to the right a little and looked down the driver's side in search of the noise that sounded like it was coming from the rear of my car. I realized that another car had lost control and was about to ram right into my rear bumper.

I felt helpless, so I froze in place and what happened next is really hard to explain! The sliding car relentlessly rammed right into my rear bumper. Then weirdly enough I felt a vertical pole or a bar (or maybe even

a post of some sort, just about the height of my body,) gently push me from in front of my car and onto the patches of grass on the ground to my left. I will discuss the positive, the negative or the right and the wrong as we go on, but please be advised that anything that isn't right is wrong and anything that is not positive is negative. When you discipline yourself to do only what is right, that is called progressing in God. Your progression in God gets better by doing things in a whole-hearted, Godly fashion. Whenever you're doing the wrong thing, you're moving in the opposite direction.

Obstacles are things, people, places, actions, events, thoughts and so on, that stop you from getting closer to God. The obstacles I'm referring to usually occur unexpectedly. To share in your pain, I must let you know about the horrible obstacles I faced while writing this book. Bazaar things occurred, which my assistant and I were able to decipher as we went on, thank God. On many occasions she would call me, in an attempt to get together and write this book but calls wouldn't make it through to my phone at all. Other times, we would actually have pen in hand and time on our side, yet we

mysteriously could not focus on the task.

Obstacles spring from negativity because negative forces have been in existence since before we were born. These negative forces are on a relentless pursuit to stop God's positive forces. For example, I know that you may buy this book and decide to read it, but for some reason you may find less and less time to get through it. In other words, you may have decided to get through this book with the best of intentions, but since this afternoon, your friends have "coincidentally" and suddenly been trying to convince you to go out. You may have difficulty finishing this book because you have an attention-needing newborn crying in another room, whom is usually the calmest of babies. You may even develop a new romance smack in the middle of the next chapter.

There are millions of obstacles out there! This chapter was written to give you a reality check. Are you spending too much time worrying about things that need to be done at work, without realizing that God is number one? Many people are, but just think: God is the reason you are alive today... God is also the reason you are reading this book. For instance, if someone distracts you from finishing this chapter today, you must come back to it once you're done with what we call "man's

will.” Man’s will is the will of man and it has nothing to do with God. You must overcome the obstacles that man’s will creates. Man’s will is a way of life where only physical desires are acknowledged. I’m here to remind you that God has created us in the form of living souls. We must learn to rely on our spirits’ ability to dictate what we do physically.

Identifying obstacles is vital in order to maneuver around them. This chapter should actually appear in multiple parts of this book, but we’ll just ask you to flip back here, sort of like a reference table, as you read on. A good way to paint a picture of what obstacles are is to think of how many hours of daylight we have in a year versus the amount of hours we have of darkness in a year. The darkness was and is abundant, but don’t ever forget that a little bit of light goes a long way. It’s time to focus on the light for a change.

CHAPTER 8

Seven Days of Happiness

I'd like to highlight something important about the creation of the world. Did you know that the Creator experienced happiness while making the world, in His Will? Well it's true and although the Koran, Torah and Bible are similar in content, I will reference the King James Version of the Bible, (I am more familiar with it.) God moves on to each new day of creation in all three books. It is important to understand what made God happy, so that we can continue to do His will. GOD IS PERFECT, SO WHATEVER HE INDICATED IN THE CREATION, WAS HIS ORIGINAL DESIRE AND LAW, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS GOD'S WILL. You don't have to question what God wants from you, once you know. You just need to do it.

Day 1:

God created Heaven and earth. His spirit moved upon the face of the waters. God created light and "[...saw that it was good. He separated the light from the darkness; calling the light day and the darkness night.]"

Breakdown: Alright, God created light, for darkness was already abundant upon the earth. Everything that God created is full of light and positive while darkness

is negative. It is easy to allow for negativity, but when you are with God, on the other hand, your world is positive.

Day 2:

God divided Heaven (above) from the waters (below.) God was and is continuously moving in his will, during this time.

Day 3:

God gathered the waters to one place, letting the dry land appear. God called the land “earth” and the waters “seas.” Again God saw that what he had done was good and was content.

Breakdown: Additionally, on day three of creation, God created grass (first vegetation) along with the trees and fruit of the earth. Seeing that it was good, God was content. It was God’s will and it was all happening just as God wanted it. God was very happy about the ecosystems He created.

Day 4:

God created the sun and the moon for daylight and nightlight; God intended for us to use the sun and the moon to determine signs, seasons, days and years. On this day, he also created the stars.

Breakdown: Here's where God tells us that if we were to study our solar system, we would find answers to life's questions. God saw that all was good and continued to create.

Day 5:

“[God . . . let the waters bring forth abundantly the moving creature that hath life, like fowl and great whales. God created every living creature that moveth and saw that it was good. God blessed them saying “be fruitful and multiply; fill the waters in the seas and let the fowl multiply in the earth.]”

Breakdown: This part in the scriptures requires a bit of attention. God is happy with his creation, so happy that he blessed his creation saying “be fruitful and multiply.”

Day 6: (BIG DAY FOR US)

And God said, Let the earth bring forth the living creature after his kind, cattle, and creeping thing, and beast of the earth after his kind: and it was so.

And God made the beast of the earth after his kind, and cattle after their kind, and everything that creepeth upon the earth after his kind: and God saw that it was good.

And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.

So God created man in His own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created He them.

And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth.

And God said, Behold, I have given you every herb bearing seed, which is upon the face of all the earth, and every tree, in the which is the fruit of a tree yielding seed; to you it shall be for meat.

And to every beast of the earth, and to every fowl of the air, and to everything that creepeth upon the earth, wherein there is life, I have given every green herb for meat: and it was so.

And God saw every thing that he had made, and, behold, it was very good. And the evening and the morning were the sixth day.

Breakdown: This has to be the most informative section in Genesis. It lays out God's will for man (male and female.) This is the foundation that you should base the rest of your life on. In collaboration with all of his creations, God created man in his own image and likeness; both male and female were created on the sixth day of creation. God blessed them saying "be fruitful and multiply, replenish the earth, subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea...and over every living thing. We have each been ordained the responsibility to maintain our planet. We should be doing everything possible to use our resources wisely, instead of devastating them. It is God's will.

God also gave us a strict diet which clearly states should only consist of "every herb bearing seed, which is upon the face of all the earth" and "...fruit of a tree-yielding seed." After "letting the earth bring forth living creature after his kind, cattle, creeping thing and beasts of the earth," God gives man authority to control the earth and everything that inhabits the earth. Remember that on the third day, God separates the waters from the dry land, calling the land "earth" and the water "seas." God

gave man full control of the earth or the land and its inhabitants. In addition, God gives man the bonus of being able to control the fish of the sea. To control means to have authority over. In other words, no matter how large and ferocious an animal may seem, it is God's will for us humans to control all other creations. In later chapters I will explain just how to manifest your ability to control.

Day 7:

The seventh day is when God ended his work, which he had made and rested. God blessed the seventh day and sanctified it.

Breakdown: God was so happy with his creation that he finally rested on the seventh day. Please realize that it is God's will to work diligently on all work every day, until it is complete. We only earn the right to rest, upon completion.

After God rested on the seventh day, he decided to create Adam. God breathed into his nostrils the breath of life. Man became a living soul; a spiritual and physical creation possessing a direct relationship with God, the Creator. Once Adam was created, God placed him in the Garden of Eden, which contained every tree that was pleasant to the sight and good for food. The tree

of life and the tree of knowledge of good and evil were also present. God took the man and put him in the Garden of Eden to dress it and keep it. God commanded Adam to eat freely of every tree except of the tree of knowledge of good and evil. God warned Adam that the day he disobeyed this commandment he would surely die as a result.

I want everyone who reads this book to realize that on the sixth day of creation God made both male and female in abundance, not Adam or Eve. It is after the seventh day that God created Adam, making him an ordained controller of the creation. Adam was the beginning of a more special human because of his direct connection and consistent communication with God. God breathed his own breath into Adam, so Adam was initially created with eternal life (immortal). Like Adam, we are all living souls, part spiritual and part physical. We all have a direct connection with God. If there were no such thing as “society,” which was created by man, we would be left with God’s creation and God. There would be no distractions and we would focus on what is truly important, God. We would live, eat and breathe God.

To further help you understand what God’s Will is, let’s consider where Adam was placed. God put him in the

GARDEN OF EDEN, where he was to carry out a God-willed diet of fruits, vegetables and water. Aren't we all searching for true health? Well, there you have it!

At birth, our bodies' pH was alkaline. Naturally, our mothers' breast milk was also very alkaline. Recent studies have shown that maintaining an alkaline body does not allow for disease (i.e. cancer cannot exist in an alkaline environment) and is the key to good health. A simple way to maintain an alkaline pH is by eating fruits and vegetables as the scripture recommends in combination with drinking plenty of healthy water, which back then was also naturally alkaline and rich in anti-oxidants.

Similar to the scriptures, this book is intended to help the reader willingly carry out God's Commandments, by not making the same mistakes that Adam and Eve made. Man's first responsibility here on earth is to again, dress and keep God's creation. This means that we should really all be involved with the maintenance and upkeep of OUR environment. Just think about it....if each person in the world obeyed God by doing their fair share and assumed responsibility, our earth would really be a wholesomely better place.

Once Adam and Eve ate the forbidden fruit, the end of an era began. It was truly the ending of the happiness that GOD felt during and after the creation. It marked the beginning of man's will. Remember that "man's will," is when man does the things that man likes to do, based on what man deems correct. Even in today's society, people behave in ways that are satisfactory only to them, but not to God. From the little bit that we do know about God, the time when God breathed the breath of life into us was joyful.

There are a few things that we can pull out from the beginning that will tell us what God loves. One would be light. God shed light upon the darkness, so if we plan to broaden our horizons, we always want to have some kind of light, meaning positive energy moving within, around and out of us at all times. That positive energy will block off negativity. Plus, if we do come across any darkness, or negative energy, the light will ultimately outshine it. The light was created by God and the darkness was abundant upon the face of the earth. Secondly, what we learned was that God has a diet for man, which consists of fruits, vegetables and water (which I spoke about earlier.) This is very important as it tells us what we should be eating in order to please God and take full advantage of all benefits God has to offer through intentionally following His original plan. As we have

realized, this is all up to us, as people to decide what we want to do. The key is: When we know right, we need to do right. Let's think hypothetically for a moment; if God directly commanded you NOT to eat of the fruit of a particular tree, would you eat that fruit? That is the question that everyone needs to ask themselves. Would you disregard what God directly asks of you? Would you obey God or would you betray God? These are the questions that you will be asked throughout this book. Now that you know.....what will you do?

CHAPTER 9

Deprogramming: What's Real? What's Not?

While in the womb, you began to utilize some of your God-given talents in that you could automatically communicate with your mother while swimming. Since birth you have been taught or conditioned to think, do, feel and believe what society deems correct or real. Once born, you were stripped of your ability to mobilize in water (at such a natural rate,) then forced to use and listen to loud voices as a form of communication. If we were never taught to speak any language, you would have most likely increased your ability to communicate telepathically. Because your telepathic transmitting brain functions are not being put to use, your telepathic receiving brain functions go into a dormant state. This is just the beginning of our accepted, daily sociological programming.

Since everything that we do is based on what society teaches us, then a complete programming is inevitable. If you were taught that everything you cannot touch or feel is real and that everything that you can see, touch and feel is not real, (but only a façade for everyday living,) you would find it very easy to put God first.

Throughout your life, you have been socially responding to stimuli (for every action, there is a reaction) or so you have been told. When babies are born their ability to respond to stimuli is tested, with a good ol' slap on the behind, confirming their ability to participate in the program. The program is of such that the doctor has no idea that he is doing this, per se'. This confirms just how oblivious we "all" are of this prevalent program. You must first acknowledge what is real. Let's go a bit further:

1. You woke up this morning - REAL
2. You breathe continuously (the breath of life) - REAL
3. You thought about how infinite the possibilities were for the day - REAL
4. You realize that you truly have no problems, once you deprogram - REAL
5. Positivity always outshines negativity REAL

Once you start to pay attention to some of the things that you take for granted, which are TRUE PRIVILEGES, YOU WILL FOCUS ON WHAT IS REAL,

NATURALLY. Realize that your continuous heartbeat requires no batteries and no recharging. Think about the beautiful ecosystems, which God has created. You can prioritize effectively once you stop living by what society deems correct. If we dissect a scenario, it may be easier to understand.

Suppose someone at work slips and falls. Let's say every single person in the room immediately bursts out in wild laughter. You can quickly choose to join in on the laughter or to completely ignore society. I suggest you realize that because people fall all the time, someone has simply fallen again. If you had never seen anyone laugh when someone fell, then a slip and fall would not be funny. As a matter of fact, most everyone knows that they should not be laughing when someone gets hurt. By not participating, you can actually do what's right and make sure the person is alright.

Now, remember when you've needed to stand up and speak or perform in front of a crowd. You would have never felt fear of criticism, unless you were taught to feel that fear. As children, we are very comfortable being ourselves. This comfort is described as "innocence." This innocence is the undisturbed, natural state of fearlessness. Fearlessness is the innate trust in God, and until disrupted, it keeps children protected. As we

grow, society depletes our fearlessness and even converts it into full-fledged fear. We now unnecessarily fear most everything, as we have been programmed. Through family (who usually learns from society), society and the media we have derailed from most of our God given capabilities. Because these gifts are infinite, society's influences are on a relentless pursuit to steer us away from the infinite power, God. Almost everything "on earth" can seem like an obstacle.

Every day, you should do all that you can, in your Godly power, to deprogram, (without getting yourself "in trouble"). You need to be humble, fearless and righteous. You also need to behave and feel righteous. Be true to yourself-we're not here to please society. We are here to rule over the earth and please God with all that we do. Without appearing extreme, we must ignore society's negative trends and expectations. This is crucial in successfully deprogramming.

Throughout the day, we encounter many subliminal tests. The only way to pass these tests is by making sure that we do what is right, according to our own hearts. Society encourages negativity, which is why once we start doing only what is right, we will break the societal mold. Have you ever come across an injured person in need, while walking down a busy street? I'm sure

many of you have. Because everyone walked right by the person who was hurt, you may have as well. How many of us have chosen to go against what society does and actually help that person in need? Deprogramming occurs when we elect to do the exact opposite of what society expects from us, in a positive way. Instead of passing the person who was hurt, then feeling heavy-hearted thereafter, you would stop and help. By doing so, you would simultaneously supersede society's expectations. The act of you stopping to lend a hand will even encourage people in society to begin deprogramming by offering their assistance. Others will then stop, and offer their assistance, after you've initiated the Godly behavior.

Deprogramming is a flow of consistent Godly actions. The motivation behind these actions comes from wanting to be closer to God and ultimately wanting to obtain ordained power. Once you establish your connection with God, you will be eternally grateful. If you're reading this book for a good read, you will accomplish that, but if you're using this book as a tool, then please know that the information provided does truly explain how you can get closer to the Creator, God. First take note of your surroundings or your environment whether it is your workplace, home, the mall or wherever. Think, for a moment about the things you would normally do

in that environment. Now think of what you could do to positively affect or change the environment, without disturbing anyone or anything. Think subtle! What comes to your mind, right this second, when I ask you how your immediate environment could be more positive? Think to yourself for a bit and come up with a sincere reply. We are all able to consciously identify ways to help others.

Now I'd like to ask that you remember the times you may have been a student in a class wanting to ask a question. Recall a time you did not ask your question due to fear of what your peers may have thought about you. Similarly, think and compile three questions that you currently fear asking. Make sure that your questions aren't offensive or hurtful. Take one of those questions and ask one every day, for three consecutive days. Be it at work, home or your good friend's house, ask the questions you fear asking most. You may find that some people don't like your curiosity and that some people may think you're silly, while others may not appear to care much. The key is that you will have asked your questions and successfully overcome society's expectation of you, in a positive way. You may get answers, but more importantly you will have chosen to ignore the potential criticisms (hindrances) in efforts to voice your inquiries. By the way, these hindrances are the

same reasons why a lot of people don't achieve much in life. These same obstacles keep a great deal of people away from realizing their goals, every day.

God has put us all here on the earth to control the earth and its creations. Scan the room, and then decide on which situation you want to control because nothing negative can happen as long as you are operating in a Godly fashion. You can finally fulfill your ordained duty, which is to control. This is truly possible for anyone who is reading this book. Meditate or concentrate on what you need accomplished, concentrate on the responses that you will generate from others and no matter how tense the situation gets, remember that you are in control. Ignore all negativity and maintain your light shining bright. This needs to be practiced throughout the day, every day until you have realized how strong you are in God.

It is important to remember that your power should be used to create positivity. If you decide to use your power to do harm or for materialistic gain, you become a sinking ship. Abusing power throws you back into man's will and away from God's will. Misusing power is actually a feeling of losing your connection with God. You need to treat your connection as the valuable and precious connection that it is. Don't be penny

CHAPTER 10

Why God?

Why should you worship God? You should worship the Creator because we as human beings fail to acknowledge that what cannot be seen and what cannot be touched is much greater than the things we can see and can touch. Society has taught us otherwise. In most cases, society has programmed us into believing that what I'm talking about is unattainable or unrealistic. This common perception is the reason so many of us wonder why we should worship or look to God for the answers that we need. In this chapter, I will provide the important, yet simple reason why we need to look for God.

God has created everything that exists, both inside and around us. Notice, if everything we do without thought is considered second nature, it's because God is first nature. We should identify the fact that if we're currently worshipping anything other than God, then we are worshipping something either created by God or something only created by one of God's creations (man). By worshipping, let's say a person, we're only worshipping God's creation and we are NOT dealing directly with the primary source. Because we are living souls we already have a built-in, direct connection with

our Creator. The Creator is worthy to be praised and we are worthy to praise God directly. Remember, we have been ordained directly by the Creator as controllers; the connection is obvious. There is nothing greater than God, and that is who we should direct our prayers to. We need to know that God is more than everything. When we pray to God, speak to God or meditate with God, we must realize who we are addressing. We must focus on who we are calling on. We should be referring to God as the Creator of Heaven and earth. Taking this a step further, when we say “God, Creator of Heaven and earth,” we should think of God and his creation. This is how we will get closer to God. There is nothing more important than God.

CHAPTER 11

God and You

To begin to understand God's Will, we must first understand ourselves. Although we are a complex organism, we have a simple gift granted to us by God, called understanding. Once we are able to understand ourselves, we have the ability to take control of who we are and what we do (behavior and actions.) Society has influenced us in a lot of ways, but most importantly into making us feel that we are not in control of ourselves. As children, we are taught specific emotional thinking patterns. For example, the concept of embarrassment is a learned behavior which is based on reactions from society to things you may do which society considers shameful. If you did the very same things that cause you embarrassment, in the absence of society, there would be no embarrassment.

It is important to be true to yourself. I don't recommend anyone become a thin outer layer of peace and harmony with a potentially-harmful volcano inside. The key is to truly identify and confront negativity. You may become upset when things don't go your way, but getting angry or "bent out of shape" is also negative. You need to remove your focus from your feelings. Focus on God. One way to address or move past your prob-

lems is to remember that there is always something to be grateful for. Taking control of yourself can easily be accomplished by effectively blocking out society's opinions, then creating and living out your own personal list of principles, values and morals.

Every moment in our lives will present us with choices. Once removed from society's influence, identifying right from wrong is simple. When something is right, we generate a positive feeling about it. On the other hand, when something is wrong, there are feelings of doubt about the decision, and remorse afterwards. Basing your lives on the principle of choosing right over wrong is an ideal way to start taking control of yourself. God's Will consists of all things positive. Not only does God give us the daily privilege to breathe, but once we are truly living in God's Will, additional benefits become available.

Once we KNOW GOD, our expectation will come solely from God. If we are said to "believe" in God or have "faith" in God, our expectation will increase or diminish (based on the amount of belief or faith, we actually have at that given moment). God's lovingkindness does not increase or diminish; it is an abundant and consistent flow that gives us the privilege to continue on with life. Society will tell us that if we cannot see

or touch something, it does not exist. As far as society is concerned, God is non-existent. If society's theory were accurate, we would be able to survive without air, because we can't see or touch it. To KNOW GOD, at all times, is to have a constant relationship with God. Every thought, every decision and all expectations are based on God. If we are connected, we are protected from the perils of man's will (society). When we know God, things that normally go wrong in society don't happen to us. We become exempt from the tragedies of man's will. If the last statements seem impossible, you are still functioning according to man's will, where doubt runs rampant. Use this opportunity to get a grip on the infinite possibilities.

Keeping God first will fortify your union with your Creator. Once you have obtained that everlasting connection, you will know that you are moving in unison with God. You will have the power to control all of God's creation. You will not feel more important than anyone, instead you will know how important everything that God has created really is. You will come to a realization that you have been given the responsibility and power to control the entire creation. This is true power and it can only be given to you by God.

We are the ordained controllers of creation. God has

put us here on earth to multiply, replenish the earth and rule over everything he has created. Once we accept and embrace this reality, we will begin to control the world. When we know God, we control what happens in society and we fear nothing because we are moving with the Master of Creation. We are automatically granted authority to control everything that is not in sync with the master of Creation. We move out of man's will and into God's will, which oversees and controls the world. In order to achieve all of this, we must live a Godly life and no negativity can exist within us. Feelings of anger, fear, confusion, doubt, depression, guilt, temptation, exclusion, segregation, oppression, conceit, envy, jealousy, hate, lust, destruction, low self-esteem, etc. are some examples of man's will. Man's will is the opposite of God's Will. Man's will is limited to the laws of society (i.e. "what goes up, must come down"). God's Will, on the other hand, is without limitation because anything is possible in GOD.

CHAPTER 12

Getting to Know God

We have forsaken God and God wants to know why. Why is it so hard to understand that our lives are made possible only through God? God has also given us free will, so that we can make our own decisions. God challenges us yet shows us that “the easy way out” in any situation is usually not the best way out. I’d like to give you an example.

There are a few ways that a body builder can build muscle. One way is through great nutrition, consistent weight-lifting and strenuous physical workouts. Another way consists of some strenuous workouts... and some steroid usage. Anyone who chooses to take the shortcut becomes a victim of poor health, which may include but is not limited to: atrophy of testicles, decreased sperm count, decreased sperm motility, fluid retention, prostate enlargement, development of breasts, baldness and psychotic episodes in males. On the other hand, anyone who chooses to work hard, while taking care of their body, can enjoy the fruits of their labor in good health. Nice and easy.

God is, was and will always be. God is everlasting, all-seeing and all-knowing. In getting to know God, it

is essential to be at peace with ourselves. This means that no matter what turmoil happens around you, your well-being is never affected. Monitor yourself. Take this moment to remember the very last time someone said something terrible to you. Did you succumb to what was said or did you overcome it? If you remember being affected in any way or if you reacted negatively in any way, you succumbed to the negativity of the situation. If you just kept your cool, heard what was said, while remaining unchanged, you have been triumphant in God's Will.

WHOLE-HEARTEDLY becoming: humble, modest, simple, patient, content, courteous, obliging, polite, reserved and respectful will prepare you, spiritually, for getting to know God. We all know what respect is. We all know what it means to be humble and polite. You must rid yourself of any personal animosity and accept the reality that God is the reason you woke up today. God is the reason you are alive, God is the reason this has been written and God is the reason you are reading this right now. Dismiss all perception of chance, luck or even coincidence. Those are merely deceptions created by the will of man to hinder you from being grateful and harnessing the limitless power that is rightfully yours (ordained by God). When you truly get to know God, he will reveal himself within

you. Again, we are living souls; God gave and gives us the daily breath of life, so we are blessed.

If you have prepared yourself to know God, you have blocked out fear. An effective way to dissolve fear is to start to understand what it is. Realize that you have the power to control every situation positively. Just because something is different or uncomfortable, it shouldn't affect you negatively. There is no need to fear anything because God created you and will always protect you.

God is all things positive. You will never have a negative experience with God. Nothing can successfully come against you, and that is the truth for anyone who truly trusts in God. Rest assured that the only fear that should ever exist is the fear of losing your connection with God. Once your connection is fully established, you will feel God's luminous presence as an ordained power. You are then able to use your ordained power to control the creation. Remember, because God gave mankind the responsibility and authority over all of his creation, you have the ability to control the world, once you know God, your Creator. Anyone who does not know God does not possess the power that has been bestowed upon those who do know God. Realize that you will be able to see what is wrong with society once

you **FINALLY KNOW GOD**. When you truly know God, your possibilities become infinite.

Too easily do we believe in any insignificant man or man-made device, however, we find it all too difficult to understand that God is the reason for and the source of our existence.

CHAPTER 13

The Power of God

God's power is the strongest force that exists in the universe. Most people are unable to acknowledge how powerful God truly is. It seems as if almost everyone takes God's power for granted. His overflowing force continually circulates throughout the entire world, every single day. We are so preoccupied with the less important things that we fail to notice just how powerful the Creator is. Yes, God wanted us to enjoy the world; however, He didn't mean for us to forget about who made it all possible.

In this chapter, you will learn about God's power and how to access it. You will do something amazingly, if not seemingly impossible and society's negativity will start to dissolve right before you. Understand the power that is bestowed upon us. Being created in God's image and likeness means that we are not just lame human beings. We are rather great, living-souls. When we are able to harness even a quarter of 1% of the power that God has bestowed upon us, we will be considered immortal. It will only take one dedicated reader who unleashes their power through God, to change mankind. Being special is normal, according to God's Will. If you've noticed this book does not speak of any laws of

attraction because these laws of attraction are utilized to facilitate materialistic gain. My emphasis is on how you can bring your spirituality full circle with the Creator. As a result, you will reap the benefits that are far greater than any worldly possession. Once you know God, you will be able to work with God's power. You will rely on the power that God has bestowed upon you. Man's will brain washes us into believing in a limited amount of physical strength. Because God has created us as living souls, we harness both physical and spiritual strength. We are taught or "programmed" to only use what is most obvious. Once we know God, the physically "impossible" becomes spiritually possible.

Some people have scratched the surface on what their soul/spirit can do. Meditation and elimination of the "program" leaves the soul/spirit to function on its own, at a low percentage. People have separated themselves from society, without taking the next step. We must each help each other do the same in order to get closer to God. Everyone can do greater things when functioning with God. People have been able to supersede what society deems possible with acts of levitation or by moving very large objects with very little physical strength. There are reported instances where some people have even been able to communicate without speech or sign language. Those individuals have suc-

cessfully deprogrammed themselves.

As we know, our physical body is prevalent, but there is an involuntary spiritual part of us that lies dormant and needs to be realized. Both portions of our being were created by God, thus both portions are to be used simultaneously with God. Our physical bodies will propel us to our physical limits and at that point our spirit takes over to complete the physical impossibilities. This is how immortality is granted.

Many religions and cults pride themselves in teaching their followers to build and control their spirits. They suggest separating the spirit from the body, long distance-spiritual travel or interactions with other spirits, using only the spirit. They even speak about spirits taking off and flying away, with no real objective. What positive impact do these spiritual acts have on society (or man's will?) The answer is none! They are selfish in their accomplishments. Again, what good is it to fly, if no one can see you? What good is it to speak to another spirit, if no other person can attest to that? Once we develop our connection with God, it is important to share that with the world around us. In doing this, we will change society, for the better. Knowing God will give you the opportunity to take control of your mind, body and soul in the best way possible; in a way that

will benefit you and everyone around you.

Again, God has given us free will. This free will allows us the freedom to make our own decisions. If we read ancient scriptures, we will most likely learn about how the masses were wicked, or negative. In most cases, one or two specific people usually decided to follow God, realizing the abundance of negativity. These people are deemed “special,” to this day. These people are referred to as: prophets, masters, shepherds or leaders. Please note that the very people who start out with such wonderful intentions are the same people who let their reputations go to their heads. The concept of leading many people while being praised, invokes man’s will or better known in this case as their ego. This ego becomes the obstacle that does not allow the follower to learn and obtain the power that God has given us all. The teacher becomes corrupt with power, therefore we’re never taught all that could have helped us access our own ordained power. Through this book, our website, blog and telephone we will give you access to helpful information and encourage you to ask questions so that you can obtain and perfect God’s power within you.

My goal is not to obtain materialistic gratification, but to actually help transform man’s will (society) into

God's Will. The art of achieving God's power is explained here because it needs to be shared with the world. It needs to be common amongst the masses. The more information you obtain from this book, the more it becomes your Godly responsibility to share the obtained information with others. If you are using this book for self gratification, you will never receive God's power at 100%. Remember that darkness is abundant, but God is infinite so it is important to remain in the light.

When you decide to communicate with God, it is vital to mentally remove yourself from man's will (society). One simple way would be by thinking about what this very moment would look like if you were to make everything that is man-made disappear. This includes all that that you are seeing, anything you are sitting or standing on...eliminate any artificially produced sounds as well. Unless you are standing in a rainforest, you've really got to put your imagination to work. Now, that light bulb that's providing artificial light, don't forget to make that disappear also. Picture your surroundings as I've asked you to. Actually, picture nothing but darkness. Let's continue using our imagination to picture just one Godly light shining into your darkness. Let that be all that you can see, all that is real. Stay focused on the light. Stare into the light and embrace the light.

Be prepared to stay focused and filter out distractions. If this is all new to you, remember that it is up to you to choose what is right. (Please see Obstacles again)

It's important that we understand that all "special" people were human beings like you and I, so when you hear names like David (who killed Goliath with just a sling and a stone after connecting with God) and Sampson who killed thousands with only a donkey's jaw bone because of his connection with God, you realize that once you truly establish your connection with God, you can expect from God to achieve the "impossible."

Before we begin, let's clear the air of any misconception you may currently have about God. I know that most of us have been taught to fear God, because of what we've heard or read (i.e. God destroys the world), but remember that God is loving and compassionate. All positive elements and forces, like unconditional love, are instrumental to God's Will. His continuous lovingkindness allows us the opportunity to breathe the daily breath of life. Now that you are about to dedicate quality time to God, do you really think He's going to scare you away? The answer is no. To feel God is to feel true unconditional love, not man's will love, which is love of ownership of something or someone. This is a love that makes you want to do whatever is necessary

to stay close to its source. God will manifest himself within you, so the closer you get to God, the better your inner being will start to feel. Remember, the only fear that you should ever have is the fear of losing your connection with God.

LESSON 1: Warm up

It is important to warm up with God. All of the traditional prayers we are accustomed to using are most likely not getting us closer to God. The easiest technique a spiritual novice can utilize is what the prophets or “blessed” have used in the past. Without sounding religious, I’d like to use David as an example. Every time he was in trouble, he poured his heart out to God, in the form of psalms, so here I’ve included a random psalm along with my interpretation of it. Please understand and visualize what you are reading in order to absorb what is happening in the psalm until you feel it.

Psalm 3 & Breakdown:

001:000 Lord, how are they increased that trouble me! Many there be that rise up against me. (Visualize a humungous tribe, consisting of people you know are against you and those who you don’t know are against you, too. Imagine that you are standing in front of all of these people who are charging at you with the worst

intentions; they want to harm you and they are getting close.)

Every day we have confrontations with people. Again, because darkness is abundant (negativity) upon the face of the earth, it is easier to have an enemy than to have a friend. Note, David's initial reaction is to call on God. If you are the victim, God is more compassionate, so he hears your prayer!

002:000 Many there be which say of my soul there is no help for him in God. Selah.

The people who dislike you or the people who are against you are blind to the fact that God can help anyone. They don't realize the greatness in God's power. Sadly, they know in their hearts that there is no help for them in God, because of their disconnection from God. They assume that the same applies to you. Selah suggests for you to meditate and pay special attention to the above verse.

003:000 But thou, O Lord, art a shield for me; my glory, and the lifter up of mine head. Visualize being protected at all sides from the negativity. The people who try to hurt you cannot harm you, they can only see you! They can't touch you.

This confirms that no matter what anyone says, you can stand confidently-fearless because God is your protector. 004:000 I cried unto the Lord with my voice, and he heard me out of his holy hill. Selah. Visualize being in the midst of all of your troubles, but because you're protected. You call on God to either remove you from the negative situation or to remove the negative situation from you.

No matter where you are, once you know that God is with you....God is with you. He hears everything you request...pay special attention to this verse.

005:000 I laid me down and slept; I awaked; for the Lord sustained me. Visualize that you are able to sleep like a baby in the middle of a battlefield. You feel safe knowing that nothing can happen to you.

When we sleep, whether we like it or not, we put all trust in God. Just being able to wake up is sufficient reason to praise God and be grateful. Although it may not make the news, many people do NOT wake up every day, so this in itself is a daily blessing!

006:000 I will not be afraid of ten thousands of people who have set themselves against me round about.

When you have God, you FEAR NOTHING. YOU ARE TRULY FEARLESS.

007:000 Arise, O Lord; Save me, O my God; for thou hast smitten all mine enemies upon the cheek bone; thou hast broken the teeth of the ungodly. Visualize the troubles dissolving. Your request is being fulfilled! The negative forces are all turned back and have no affect on you!

When you move with God, you have the ability to call on God and get results...fast. People who are against you will have a hard time carrying out their negativity, because you KNOW GOD! In an attempt to hurt you, these people end up hurting themselves.

008:000 Salvation belongeth unto the Lord: thy blessing is upon thy people. Selah.

God controls all blessings, so once you know God you are blessed.

WHO GOD BLESSES, NO MAN CAN CURSE!

Along with all of your negative feelings, audacity, surety, confidence and focus on the light, you must pour your heart out to God, leaving no stone unturned; releas-

ing everything, while simultaneously speaking to God. For many readers, psalms are a great tool in achieving this. For others, prayers which prophets used and got results from, will suffice. It is essential to confirm that the prayer you choose addresses the Creator directly. Once you've selected a prayer, think about what problems you currently encounter. This includes the very things that are making you feel depressed, angry, remorseful, rejected, doubtful or any other negativity. Now take everything that's bothering you and place it in your heart. You can do it, just ball it up and put it in your heart. Your chest may feel as if it could burst open, but God won't let that happen.

Read a psalm or say your prayer and whole-heartedly (with all of your heart) pour your heart out to God. Continue by asking the Creator of Heaven and earth to release all of the negativity from you. You will watch all of your problems disappear. As all of this is taking place, remember to stay focused on the light, and you will begin to feel relieved of some of your pressures. As soon as you feel that, take advantage by asking for the greatness that God has to offer. Initially, this includes (but is not limited to) a continuous connection with God, happiness, wisdom, patience and anything that you feel will take you out of man's will. Repeat this exercise until you have truly alleviated yourself of

all of your problems, because you will. You will realize that God is the answer to any “problem,” so once you have God, you have no problems. Like the cells in our bodies, our souls need to continuously absorb nutrients (positivity) and expel wastes (negativity) at a healthy (Godly) rate. By being consistent with this you will literally feel light! Society’s definition of homeostasis is a balance of all systems in the body, which is only physical. Godly homeostasis is a balance of everything that God has given us, which includes body and soul.

LESSON 2 BECOME MORE SPIRITUAL

To have physical strength is great, but limited. The spirit is the infinite portion of all human beings. Our spirit makes us immortal in society’s eyes, but normal in God’s eyes. Society limits us to what we can and cannot do. Through our spirits we connect to God and we are granted the ability to do the things that are considered impossible.

Once you have freed yourself of all problems and have allowed God to be a part of your life, society will see you as a different person. Even your physical appearance will start to change for the better, as your spirituality will begin to shine within you. It won’t be odd to begin hearing how much you have changed and how

wonderful you suddenly look from people who see you every day. Strangers will be drawn to you as they too will notice how special you are. Do not fall victim to all of the attention you will be receiving because it's great to know you look good, but it's only a physical compliment. Focus in on God to keep Him first and present. Thank God for all that he is doing as often as possible. This is maintenance, keeping you at spiritual homeostasis throughout your days.

Your spirit is ready to do its job. It will start to manifest itself daily through dreams, visions and intuition. You will also start to feel privileged in society, as things will just start to go your way. Remember that darkness is abundant and will continually try to steal your joy. Don't allow one negative situation to overshadow all of the good that God is doing for you. When you communicate with God and you're focused in on the light, your spirit will start to outgrow your body. You will feel your infinite love and desire for God increase. You will know at these instances that you are being listened to (not just heard by God) and that any Godly request will be fulfilled.

When I first started to harness my spirit, I was still connected to society and I would ask God for materialistic blessings. I was granted everything I ever asked for.

What I realized was that materialistic blessings are temporary because you have to dedicate your time, attention and focus to the materialistic maintenance, which pulls you away from God. If you read scriptures, you will see that it is said that God is a jealous God. Jealousy is a man's-will word and it consists of negative energy, but the jealousy that the scriptures refer to with God is the idea that you are one of the few people in the world who decided to dedicate your time and attention to God, so be sure to keep God first, even after he has granted you what you asked for. Do not forget about God. For those who are already spiritually-Godly, materialistic gain isn't a priority because daily they will choose God over anything else.

You must truly decide on whether or not you have alleviated yourself from society because some of you may be able to harness the balance of body and spirit quickly, while others will need more patience to complete the process. Patience is the most important attribute necessary in bringing yourself into a balance. Negative forces can easily linger where patience is lacking, ultimately slowing you down from becoming Godly. The technique explained in this lesson is proven and works, but again, requires whole-hearted dedication and patience. Do not get discouraged, for that is also negative, which will keep you away from reaching your goal.

Once society realizes that you have God, it will stop at nothing to create obstacles. Intentionally and unintentionally, it will try to interfere in your continuous connection. As I have mentioned before, it is imperative that you continually keep a light in front of any situation that may present itself throughout the day. At times, the light may appear to be semi-blocked off by different situations, but as situations pass we must focus back in on the light and keep God first, as a part of daily maintenance. Once you have locked your imagination in on the light, your thought process should sound something like this:

“Because no person or materialistic object can ever come between me and my connection with God I will keep God’s light first...then that big raise I’m expecting after. God’s light comes first and then that luxurious car I have after.”

Let this light become a part of you. Imagine a miner’s hard hat (fully equipped with a flashlight on the front.) The light that shines should illuminate your way. Without it, everything is darkness. Everything you do must consist of you whole-heartedly putting and keeping God first. This is the only way anything is considered blessed.

As you wait for God to manifest within you, the most important daily exercise to practice is to just acknowledge the fact that God is present, at every moment, even right now. Know that it is impossible for any negativity to affect you once you've replaced doubt with God. Unless you decide to run your car into a wall for example or hit someone with it, once you are with God, fatal accidents will not take place. God does work in mysterious ways, so take note that sometimes certain things will happen in efforts to prevent an even greater tragedy. In other words, you are accident-free. Anything that happens will have a great reason behind it. To help you visualize what I mean, let's imagine that you're driving to an out-of-town party.

At this party there are people waiting for you who have devious intentions. Let's add that the possibility of a fatal tragedy awaits you at this gathering. A situation like this may call for serious divine intervention. God's will may allow for your tire to "spontaneously" burst open as you drive. You may even collide with another driver, just to keep you away from the greater tragedy. You may damage your car a bit, but you will remain intact.

I know from experience. I got up and got ready for an auction in upstate New York one morning, which was an hour-and-a-half drive from where I was. Although

I was relying on God, like always, I had reservations about going. I left my house and ten minutes into driving, a bad feeling about one of my tires randomly came over me. I didn't know why, but in my mind, I had planned and decided that if my tire went flat, I would repair it and drive right back home. About forty-five minutes into my trip, my tire went flat! Fortunately, I was able to roll off the parkway and straight to a tire-repair shop. I "conveniently" spotted one exactly one block away. At that point, my greed (man's will) for money kept me on the fence about going back home, as I had initially said I would.

I thought to myself for a moment then came up with a request. I asked God to confirm that I should go home instead of continuing on with my plan to attend this auction. I more specifically asked God to have a police officer stop me (without giving me a ticket) as a clear sign that I needed to turn back and head home. Sure enough, I drove for less than a mile, when...I received my confirmation just as I had asked. I was stopped by a state trooper and I was successful in negotiating my way out of a ticket but what's more is that he allowed me to cross over the median after I told him that I desperately wanted to head back home. Special. So you see, when you know God and trust only in God, you are guided through daily life.

You're starting to get to know God. You've actually been able to feel His presence and although overwhelming to some of us, it's something that you wish you could have every minute of the day. The objective is to maintain your connection throughout your daily life. It is the feeling of being more privileged than anyone else and almost makes you feel overly proud. As a matter of fact, the next time you sneeze, and someone says "God bless you," you'll be tempted to say "I know," instead of "thank you." Part of this, is your new-found ability to control the world... This would make anyone feel important, but although it is nice to be important, it is more important to be nice, so be humble!

God is first. The breath of life that God makes possible, is God. Without water we last a few days. Without food we can survive a few weeks, but how long can we live without air? Please note the order of importance, for it is very clear. Without air, we can't survive. God is first.

CHAPTER 14

A Better Person

Now that we know what God's will and man's will is, we can take the time and steps necessary towards becoming a better person, in God. Knowing right from wrong and choosing to do right while keeping a positive attitude is possible for any human being, whether they are Godly or not. Maintaining a true Godly connection throughout daily life has been achieved by very few people because of the things we've been taught.

I have laid out several ways that can help you find the right path in your life. Think of your life's destination as an inevitable place. Now picture a number of different paths that all lead to that same destination. Some of these paths may involve bumpier terrain than others. Now, picture one exceptionally well-lit and highly maintained path; this path stands out from all the rest. This path I am describing is yours when you choose to do right. Even if it takes you longer to reach your destination, it will consist of less conflict because when you approach a situation in a Godly fashion, you are protected. It is vital to have good intentions. Doing great things to gain acceptance from others will be viewed by people (society) as kind gestures, but kind gestures can only take you so far. When you consult with God,

before doing the things that you want to do and take whole-hearted action in God or when you make an effort to appease God, you simultaneously bypass seeking society's recognition or compensations. While others are thanking you, you are thanking God, for granting you life and for the ability to help others.

We hear stories about people who save others from potential tragedies, who then vanish unexplainably. These are the people who whole-heartedly set out to appease God (only) by doing the best they can in every situation. These deeds are NOT premeditated; they are randomly righteous reactions. Once they help a person in need, they carry on with their lives. They don't wait around for a pat on the back. They realize that society's acknowledgments and compensations are NOT important. A better person cares only about God's judgment. What's so wonderful is that while maintaining a great rapport with God, you don't affect society negatively. Everything falls in place and you may even appear to be a better person to those who are ungodly.

A better person is fearless and compassionate, which means you can confront any situation ... and help. Even the most severe situations are yours to control. Society has done an excellent job at instilling fear in efforts to control society. Learn to be valiant and hum-

ble, it's actually first nature. Know in your heart that there is nothing in this world that can successfully come against you.

A great exercise I recommend is learning to ignore the unexpected. Let me give you an example. If someone shatters a glass near you, do not allow yourself to be startled. Train yourself! Try to realize that because glass can break, it has broken. Direct your attention to these situations leisurely. Do the same with any loud noises, confrontations, criticism or surprising news. The key is to overcome fear...of anything and everything.

Let me give you an example. One evening a colleague/pastor and I took a flight on a prominent airline to the Dominican Republic. When we boarded the aircraft, we were very surprised at how trendy the atmosphere was. Small monitors that displayed weather, time and altitude of the aircraft could be found in front of each passenger. On top of that, the flight was pretty empty, so I was allowed the luxury of being able to make myself comfortable, using up all of three seats. My pastor friend took a seat next to me across the aisle. As I lay there, I started to doze off.

About two hours into the flight, the aircraft started to experience turbulence, which woke me up from my

light sleep. The aircraft was trembling and swaying from side to side, shaking up all of the passengers. This went on for a few minutes until something unforeseen happened. The aircraft seemed to drop an unbelievable thousand feet, in seconds. The free-fall removed the airplane from under me, leaving me suspended in the air until the roof of the aircraft met my head (ouch!) All I could hear was a collection of heart-wrenching and excruciating screams. The shrilling noise sounded like death was calling and everyone around me was terrified. Once the aircraft stopped falling, I fell right back into the three seats, same position and all. My leg had fallen off the seat, but I quickly adjusted my pillow and got back to relaxing. I laid there staring at my monitor for a minute, checking the altitude.

Not long after, I started to fall asleep again. The environment was still tense, but the fear seemed to settle a bit. No one said a word, not even the pilot. People were still vomiting and trying to keep calm but the pilot seemed to have gained control of the situation. Unfortunately, ten minutes later, my sleep was again rudely interrupted by what seemed like an eight hundred foot plunge. That time it wasn't as convenient. I totally missed the seats on my way back down, but I wasn't hurt or anything. I got myself together and again spread out on the three seats with my pillow. I didn't

say a word and instead thought to myself for a moment. Outbursts and cries grew loud. Once again I realized that because I was protected by God, everyone else on that flight was protected as well.

Although, they may have been clueless at the time, every passenger on that flight was protected from a greater tragedy, that day, because someone on the airplane knew God. I laid down in the seats for about another minute then I sat up to look across the aisle where my pastor-friend sat. He was red-faced and crying frantically. I proceeded to ask him; what's wrong? Sobbing, he replied "how can you be so calm? Didn't you see what just happened? I said "yes" and continued to ask him "don't you have faith in God?" Because actions speak louder than words, I was incredibly appalled by his reaction as a pastor, and chose not to say much more for the duration of the flight. Only someone expecting the worst would react as he did. The entire aircraft remained silent until we reached our destination. Everyone was still upset with the airline because of their near-death-like experience. It was much easier to doubt and fear than it was to trust and feel protected, but I put my trust in God because I know I'm protected and he did not let me down.

CHAPTER 15

In God We Trust

We all find it easy to put our trust in the people around us. We're always asking each other "do you trust me?" Please understand that trust is based on what we believe someone will or will not do. Our trust should NEVER, EVER lie within a person because in doing so, we give people the opportunity to fail us. Trust becomes a doubtful word once we put it in people because people cannot always do what they say they will. Once we all KNOW this, we will also KNOW that there will never be a reason for us to resent, criticize or hold grudges towards anyone. Forgiveness becomes automatic because we are no longer expecting anyone to uphold our expectations.

A system has been created that can guarantee that every day people stay far away from God, the Creator. The very people who claim it is not right to bring religion into politics or any type of public place are the very people using the power that God blesses us with. This is no conspiracy nor am I giving any one reason to be upset, this is simply more of a reason to pursue your direct connection to the Creator. I realized that the government is well aware that God is the most important power on the face of the earth. They actually find

it important to print “IN GOD WE TRUST” on American currency. Most of what we’re looking for in life is in plain sight! They are worshiping God every day because they KNOW that God’s power is the only power that really exists. Through this they are able to basically control the world. Everyone can become powerful in God and gain control because God is infinite.

Only the Creator is to be trusted. It’s hard to trust someone that is weak, but much easier to trust in something that is very strong. Trusting in people is like going over an old, broken-down bridge made of wood and rope. At any given time it can give way. When you’re crossing a bridge made of steel and in excellent condition, in your mind there is usually never a thought about that bridge collapsing. This is the same way that we need to be sure about God. Forget about everything else. For example, you should trust in God that your friends will not betray you. Someone can only betray you if you expect them to fulfill an expectation. You should no longer expect anything from anyone, instead expect only from God. God will make sure that you stand confident knowing that you didn’t put your trust in anyone other than Him. We must rely only on God for everything.

If you want to continue living a regular societal life,

where you are captive in your own land, you can continue to follow man-made leaders. When you genuinely choose to get in touch with your true power, trusting in God will be innate. It will require that you relinquish all doubt, as I mentioned in earlier chapters. Applying this in everyday life is vital. Your days will sound something like this: You get in your car and you drive to work knowing that God will get you there and back safely. You've got to know this. You must know that everything that you choose to do during the day will be Godly. You have to know that nothing negative can happen to you. Know that when you walk back into your home things are going to be in order. Know that your family is well. Know that everything around you is just the way that it's supposed to be. Know that no matter what obstacle comes before you, you will easily find a solution and move forward. Your trust in God should be connected fully; every time you spot a problem, your trust in God should remain steadfast. Walk in the light of God and trust that everything will flow in a Godly fashion. Once you have done that, you will be successfully in the KNOW. Once you are in the KNOW you are working with God. Let us all completely trust in God.

CHAPTER 16

The Question

“Knock, knock.” I start out towards the front door, which was not too far away from anything in the little house. As I let Rich and his girlfriend Alicia into my living room, I called my girlfriend in from my bedroom. Although Rich and I usually talk business, that night’s hot topic was personal relationships. My girlfriend jumped in sharing her opinion about what our relationship should have been like and Alicia quickly chimed in, agreeing with every word. Rich and I objected to most of what these girls were ranting about and before I knew it, we were smack in the middle of a biased debate. These girls were not too happy, especially my girlfriend.

In efforts to extinguish the tension, I walked over to my kitchen while signaling discreetly for Rich to follow suit. He was startled by my Bible as he entered the kitchen. Rich said “I see you have a bible on your kitchen table” and proceeded to ask me “are you a Christian?” I thought to myself for a minute and because I do believe in the existence of Jesus Christ and his teachings, my words to Rich were “Yes, I am a Christian, are you?” His answer was “Yeah, I’m a Christian. I attend a church in Rockville Centre” and he continued

by promoting his church and describing how casual the dress code was.
